State Representative Kevin Ambler to discuss state budget and homeowner issues with public, members at PACA's September 10 meeting in Land O' Lakes.

LAND O' LAKES – State Representative Kevin Ambler will discuss community issues at the September 10 meeting of the Pasco Alliance of Community Associations (PACA).

The meeting, open to the public as well as to PACA members, begins at 7 p.m. on Thursday, September 10, at the Land O' Lakes Community Center located at 5401 Land O' Lakes Blvd. (US 41), three miles north of SR 54.

Representative Kevin C. Ambler (R) serves in the Florida State House of Representatives, District 47. District 47 is located in Northwest Hillsborough County. He previously served on the following committees during past terms as a State Representative: *Chair*- Joint Committee on Government Accountability, **Select Committee on Condominium & Homeowners Association Governance**, Education Innovation and Career Preparation Committee, Utilities & Telecommunications Committee, Policy and Budget Council, Courts Committee, Business Regulation, Energy, Commerce, Health Appropriations, Joint Legislative Auditing, Judiciary, Local Government & Veterans' Affairs, Veterans' & Military Affairs, Select Committee for Florida's Economic Future, and Select Committee for National Defense & Space Related Economic Development. He also served as the Speaker's Liaison for Military & Veterans' Issues.

PACA President Bill Parsons said, "PACA members are looking forward to the September 10th meeting because State Rep. Kevin Ambler will be the guest speaker. His District does not cover any part of Pasco County, but he is a very important State Representative for PACA as he drafts legislation that impacts the CDDs and HOAs. When Rep. Weatherford spoke to PACA in May, he said that the Florida House of Representatives was not able to work legislation that would help resolve HOA issues because they were focused on trying to balance the state budget. Since the state representatives now plan to consider HOA legislation during the next session, PACA feels that it is very important to be able to give Rep. Ambler what members believe should be considered by the Florida Legislature during the **next session.**"

PACA is a not-for-profit organization whose members include representatives from 75 of Pasco County's homeowner associations, community development districts and condominium associations. PACA assists members by educating them on common issues and finding solutions to shared problems. It also represents the interests of members before all levels of government.
