**County Clerk/Comptroller Paula O'Neil to discuss the "Online Foreclosure Auction" with public, members at PACA's December 10, 2009 meeting in Land O' Lakes.**

LAND O' LAKES – County Clerk/Comptroller will discuss the foreclosure process at the December 10 meeting of the Pasco Alliance of Community Associations (PACA).

The meeting, open to the public as well as to PACA members, begins at 7 p.m. on Thursday, December 10, at the Land O' Lakes Community Center located at 5401 Land O' Lakes Blvd. (US 41), three miles north of SR 54.

PACA President Bill Parsons said, "The December meeting will be the Annual meeting where three candidates will be elected to fill the positions of three Board members whose terms expire at the end of the year. The members are especially looking forward to the presentation by Paula O'Neil, Pasco County's Clerk and Comptroller, on the foreclosure process as this is a concern for each of the PACA members. Another concern of PACA members is the new state law that does not allow associations to prohibit any property owner from implementing Florida Friendly Landscaping. James Bradley, who is a representative of an HOA that is a member of PACA, will provide a brief summary of what was covered on this issue at a recent Southwest Florida Water Management District Workshop. This meeting will provide the PACA members with not only information for their Association members but some new Board members for 2010."

PACA is a not-for-profit organization whose members include representatives from 75 of Pasco County's homeowner associations, community development districts and condominium associations. PACA assists members by educating them on common issues and finding solutions to shared problems. It also represents the interests of members before all levels of government.
