## December 11, 2008 Going Green

Chris' presentation was on "Lean and Green Communities", Karen explained how nonprofit organizations get free items at "Creative Station", and Jennifer informed the members about how and what items can be recycled in Pasco County. At this Annual PACA meeting, there was also an election to fill four Board positions.

## January 8, 2009 Commissioner Cox

Commissioner Cox briefed the PACA members on what actions the County is taking to deal with the impact that the significantly reduced County income will have on the services that they can provide to Pasco residents. For example, he explained that they do not have any funds to build new libraries and even though there is money to build new fire stations, there are no funds to operate them. Melissa Cone, a PACA member, also briefed the members on the concerns they should have about a company requesting approval to build a 40-bed Mental Health Facility in Wesley Chapel area.
