February 12, 2009 Dick Ortiz

Bill Parsons shows Dick Ortiz, Pasco County Code Compliance Manager, a map that shows the location of PACA's members. Dick Ortiz, who gave a presentation to PACA on February 12th, explained how the budget cuts have affected his office. He said residents can contact the Code Compliance Office six ways: 1) telephone 2) walk-in 3) mail 4) email 5) fax 6) web site. After his presentation, he answered numerous questions from the members. On February 13th, Dick Ortiz resigned. A replacement has not been named.

March 12, 2009 TBARTA

Brian Bollas, Transportation Planner for the Tampa Bay Area Regional Transportation Authority (TBARTA), explained that transportation in the area is getting worst everyday and the solutions for each County stop at the County line. To solve this problem, the State Legislature created TBARTA on July 1, 2007. They were charged with creating a transportation master plan by July 1, 2009 for a seven county area from Citrus County to Sarasota County for multi modal transportation system involving cars, buses, train, and ferry for passengers and freight.
