LAND O' LAKES – Pasco County Property Appraiser, Mike Wells, will speak on property appraisal issues at the June 10, meeting of the Pasco Alliance of Community Associations (PACA).

The meeting, open to the public as well as to PACA members, begins at 7 p.m. on Thursday, June 10, at the Land O' Lakes Community Center located at 5401 Land O' Lakes Blvd. (US 41), three miles north of SR 54.

He was elected to the office of Property Appraiser in 1997 and was re-elected in 2004 and 2008. His extensive real estate and appraisal background makes him well suited to be Pasco County's Property Appraiser. He is responsible for fairly and equitably assessing all real property in Pasco County, as well as for granting or denying applications for all types of exemptions.
