LAND O' LAKES – Pasco County Sheriff, Bob White, will speak on public safety issues at the August 12, meeting of the Pasco Alliance of Community Associations (PACA).

The meeting, open to the public as well as to PACA members, begins at 7 p.m. on Thursday, August 12, at the Land O' Lakes Community Center located at 5401 Land O' Lakes Blvd. (US 41), three miles north of SR 54.

Sheriff Bob White is serving in his third term; originally he was elected in November 2000. The Mr. White has lived in Florida for more than thirty years. The Sheriff's Office provides law enforcement for the unincorporated areas of Pasco County.
