Pasco schools superintendent to address homeowners

Pasco County's superintendent of schools will discuss school boundaries, class sizes and other issues when she addresses the Pasco Alliance of Community Associations on Thursday, Feb. 10.

The public is invited to attend the meeting. It begins at 7 p.m. at the Land O' Lakes Community Center, located at 5401 Land O' Lakes Blvd. (US 41), three miles north of SR 54.

Superintendent of Schools Heather Fiorentino will also discuss budget matters and the academic issues facing the district. Ms. Fiorentino brings a wealth of experience to the superintendent's post she has held since 2004. She has hands-on experience as a teacher from 1984-98, before serving as a Florida state representative from 1998-2004.

After her remarks, Ms. Fiorentino will answer questions from PACA members and the public.

PACA president Jim Flateau said, "Few issues are more important than educating today's children to compete in tomorrow's world and to become its leaders. Pasco County offers parents, their children and all taxpayers a public school system that is among the best in Florida. Ms. Fiorentino's presentation will detail how the district is preparing our children to face the challenges that lie before them."
