Pasco commissioner to address homeowners

Pasco's newest county commissioner will discuss his thoughts and goals when he meets for the first time with the Pasco Alliance of Community Associations on Thursday, March 10.

The public is invited to attend the meeting. It begins at 7 p.m. at the Land O' Lakes Community Center, located at 5401 Land O' Lakes Blvd. (US 41), three miles north of SR 54.

Henry Wilson was elected in November 2010, representing the county's west-central District #4. Mr. Wilson has spent 14 years in the health care field, most recently as director of managed care for SDI Diagnostic Imaging, a 25-physician radiology group in Tampa. His efforts on the Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board are aimed at creating a better transition for graduating seniors to either the workforce or for furthering their education. He is on the Tampa Bay Regional Partnership Council for the Area Agency on Aging.

After his remarks, Mr. Wilson will answer questions from PACA members and the public.

PACA president Jim Flateau said, "PACA congratulates Commissioner Wilson on his election. PACA has a long-standing and positive relationship with county leaders. All of us have the common goal of working for the benefit of all Pasco residents. We welcome Mr. Wilson and look forward to hearing the goals, proposals and initiatives that he brings to the table."
