Sen. Fasano to discuss legislative highlights with Pasco homeowners

State Sen. Mike Fasano will discuss the just-completed state legislative session in Tallahassee when he addresses the Pasco Alliance of Community Associations' monthly meeting beginning at 7 p.m. on Thursday, June 9.

The public is invited to attend the PACA meeting. It begins at 7 p.m. at the Land O' Lakes Community Center, located at 5401 Land O' Lakes Blvd. (US 41), three miles north of SR 54.

Sen. Fasano, R-New Port Richey, will discuss new legislation affecting homeowner groups and landowners, as well as budgetary priorities and policies that affect all Floridians. He will also focus on insurance legislation and measures to deal with "pill mills" that improperly dispense prescription medications. He will answer questions from PACA members and the public following his remarks.

PACA president Jim Flateau said, "Each year, the legislature and governor take actions that impact upon landowners and community groups. This is a return visit to PACA by Sen. Fasano, and our members once again look forward to his candid insight on, and frank assessment of, legislative actions."

PACA assists members by educating them on common issues and finding solutions to shared problems. It also represents the interests of members before all levels of government.
